Southland Captures School Success in New Video

Southland Energy (Business Silver) has a [new video](#) out that spotlights the company's work with the private St. Anne's Belfield School in



Charlottesville. The company installed comprehensive energy and water saving upgrades for the school, including seven buildings across two campuses. The measures – ranging from lighting fixtures to irrigation – reduced the school's carbon footprint by 28 percent, will save more than 1 million gallons of water a year, and save \$4.5 million over the project life.
