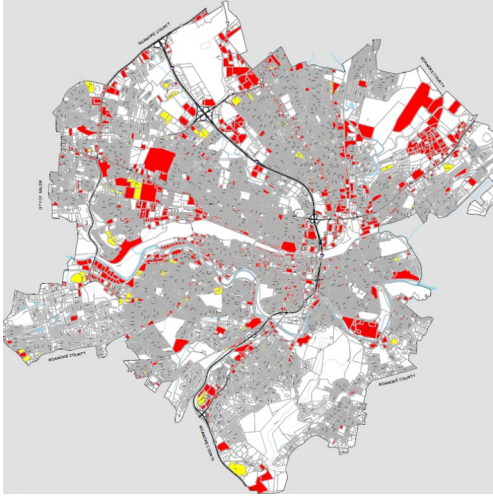

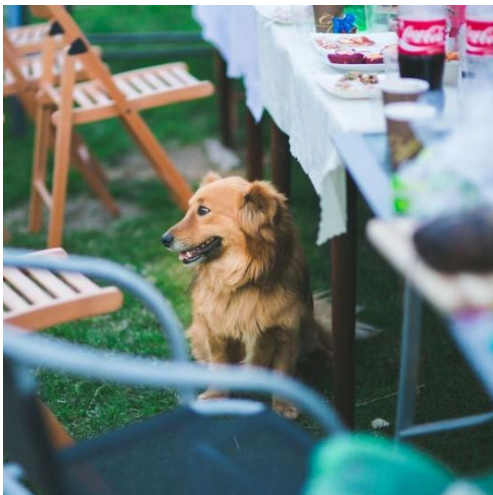
PACE. The VAEEC will continue to be a resource for local governments considering C-PACE and to work with stakeholders to get more C-PACE programs launched throughout Virginia.
