CASE STUDY: NOTTOWAY COUNTY

Weatherization Deferral Repair (WDR) Funds Improving Senior Apartments

THE CHALLENGE

The seniors in the Deerfield Apartments are like much of Crewe, Virginia - lifetime residents of the community on a fixed



income. When the

apartment homes deteriorated beyond what federal weatherization funds would cover, the residents were left with very few options to **improve their** health, safety, and livelihood.

THE SOLUTION

Using Weatherization Deferral Repair (WDR) funds - made possible by the RGGI auctions - local Weatherization Assistance Provider Project:HOMES was able to make **needed health and safety repairs** on 39 units of the Deerfield Apartments. "These funds were used to replace several roofs on the property to enable us to move forward with the [federal weatherization] energy improvements", said Bryan Burris, Director of Utility Programs, Energy Conservation at Project:HOMES. "Without these additional resources, our agency would not have been able to serve this particular community."
